Plumlee also stated, noting his concern for his own safety, that a former associate of his in Florida was missing and his whereabouts was unknown.

Plumlee advised that he had recently furnished information to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) in Phoenix and that apparently they did not believe in the quality of the information or his past credentials.

Plumlee was advised by the interviewing Agents that the FBI was not in a position to determine whether or not he was to be subpoenaed before a Congressional investigating committee and what the topic of the subpoena might be. Plumlee indicated that he had been involved in border-line cases and incidents in the past and that in each instance the FBI and the CIA had been advised or been aware of his activities. He said that he has always desired to stay within the law but he was interested in making money as a contract pilot and as a result, he was associated at times with unsavory persons.

On August 2, 1976, Plumlee again telephoned the Phoenix Division. Plumlee's conversation was basically the same as shown above and it was during this conversation that he advised he had received a threatening phone call. When questioned concerning this call, he indicated it was a vague call and that he is not sure of its origin or the identity of the caller. Throughout the conversation, Plumlee indicated that he was concerned with testifying before a Congressional committee in that he was involved in many operations in the past and fears for his safety if he is requested to divulge names and details of these operations.

A Special Agent advised Plumlee that should he be subpoenaed that he has the right to seek advice and counsel through an attorney. As to the so-called threat, he was advised that if he felt he was in imminent danger, he should contact the Phoenix Police Department.

On August 5, 1976; Plumlee telephoned the Phoenix Division about the United Press International publicity that normally is given to the operations of the Phoenix Division.
