Re Cincinnati Airtel to Bureau, dated 5/19/59.

[redacted] Bureau of Customs, 303 United States Customs House, Detroit, Michigan, advised on May 26, 1959, that United States Customs had no interest in the Subject. He stated when the Subject was arrested in Columbus, Ohio, he was turned over to local authorities in view of his location being so far inland, it would be impossible to prove attempts to ship arms to Cuba.
